Tests to be made before a plastic surgery under general anesthesia:

- 1. Clinical blood count (complete blood count + platelets)
- 2. Clotting time and bleeding time
- 3. Blood group and Rhesus factor
- 4. Clinical urinalysis with microscopic sediment examination
- 5. Biochemical blood test:
 - total protein
 - creatinine
 - urea
 - bilirubin
 - ALT
 - AST
 - Glucose
- 6. Coagulogram:
 - prothrombin
 - fibrinogen
 - PTT Partial thromboplastin time (A-PTT Activated partial thromboplastin time)
 - Thrombin time
 - INR (International Normalized Ratio)
 - D-dimer
- 7. Lab tests for:
 - Hepatitis B
 - Hepatitis C
 - HIV
 - Syphilis
- 8. Fluorography made within the past 12 months
- 9. Ultrasound of vessels: veins of lower extremities
- 10. Electrocardiogram with interpretation and ECG trace
- 11. Echocardiogram for patients over 50 (before face and neck rejuvenation surgeries, abdominoplasty, liposuction and large volume lipofilling)
- 12. Consultation with a physician, conclusion on contraindications to the surgery.
- 13. Following documents for women:
 - Breast ultrasound + mammologist's opinion (for breast surgery)
 - Pelvic ultrasound + gynecologist's opinion for patients over 40
- 14. Covid19 test
